Children will:

- Learn What Makes A Good sentence
- Write a fact file based on the story 'Astro Girl'
- Explore the story tale "Not Now Bernard"
- Orally rehearse and sequence sentences to create a story
- Take part in Daily Supported Reading
- Have daily phonics lessons

So that they...

Begin to write successful simple sentences
Write a complete sentence with a capital letter, finger spaces and punctuation including full stops.
Plan, draft, edit and publish a story and fact file
Apply their phonics knowledge when writing and reading
Develop fluency and reading comprehension

Music

Children will:

- Learn a range musical vocabulary
- Respond to dynamic changes in a piece of music
- Perform simple pieces of music

So that they...

Define the musical terms of pulse, tempo, dynamics, pitch and rhythms.

Art

Children will:

- Explore the work of Beatriz Milhazes
- Use a range of mark making techniques
- Blend and mix primary colours to make secondary colours

So that they...

Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, line, shape and space

Physical Education

Children will:

- Have weekly indoor and outdoor PE lessons
- Explore a range of motion
- Navigate floor and apparatus spaces safely

So that they...

Learn to move in a controlled manner
Develop a short movement routine involving gymnastic movement and balance

Science

Children will:

- Explore everyday materials
- Name materials
- Use their senses to feel materials
- Explore how some materials can be changed

So that they...

Identify the materials around them and talk about their suitability for particular uses
Describe the properties of everyday materials using scientific vocabulary

Computing

Children will:

- Learn about E-Safety
- Identify different forms of IT
- Use a mouse to click and drag
- Use a keyboard to type, delete and edit

So that they...

Understand how to stay safe online
Create rules for using technology responsibly

Maths

Children will:

- Work with and compare numbers up to 10
- Count forwards and backwards to and from 10
- Say 1 more/1 less than a number to 10
- Make number bonds to 10

So that they...

Can order and compare numbers
Know and use number relationships
Begin to develop a written strategy for addition
Are confident and able to use numbers up to 10 within a range of mathematical situations.

Geography

Children will:

- Look at photos of the local area
- Look at a range of maps
- Create maps of different locations
- Give directions using left, right, forwards & backwards

So that they:

Develop knowledge about their locality
Use locational and directional language
Devise a simple map involving key

PSHE

Children will:

- Explore rights of a child
- Create a class charter
- Find out about class Dojos

So that they...

Understand our rights and responsibilities
Have a safe and happy learning environment
Understand what is expected of them in a learning space

Religious Education

Children will:

- Look at what makes someone a good friend?
- Learn religious stories of friendship
- So that they...

Understand why it is important to have good friendship.
