I wanted to take this last opportunity to say thank you to you all. No one person can do everything but together we are stronger.


Harbinger will go from strength to strength if you all continue to work together as one community.

We also met two really cool engineers who told us all about their job.



JOUD: My barney powers will save her


BARNEY: Yaaas Joud. Yeeeees Joud you made me proud

NUMAIRAH: Soooo teacher Tom is coming although i literally stupified him


SHE BUILDS UK


