- Use a range of punctuation in their written work
- Use adjectives, verbs and adverbs to write descriptive sentences
- Use conjunctions to extend their sentences
- Critically read their own work to edit and improve
- Research and decipher through information to support their knowledge
- Take part in Daily Supported Reading
- Have daily phonics or grammar lessons

So that they...

- Verbally articulate their ideas clearly and confidently
- Write and edit a successful descriptive story
- Write and edit and publish an information report
- Apply their phonics knowledge when writing and reading
- Develop fluency and reading comprehension

HistoryChildren will:

- Explore the lives of 3 significant historical individuals
- Find out about important changes that these people brought about
- Learn about what lives were like before and after each of these changes
- Empathise with people who lived in those times

Understand that people can bring about significant change to the way people live in the world
Understand that the way we live now has not always been the same

ArtChildren will:

- Explore the colours of Turner's seascapes
- Paint with watercolours

Understand how to use watercolour paint effectively
Create a seascape painting using multiple paint techniques

ScienceChildren will:

- Learn about famous scientist and inventors
- Revisit knowledge and skills learnt throughout this year
- Complete practical investigations

So that they...

Deepen their understanding of scientific concepts that have been taught this year
Develop working scientifically skills

MathsChildren will:

- Apply the 4 maths operations to measurement to solve problems
- Collect data and present it in different graphs and charts
- Describe movement and turning
- Consolidate their year 2 maths learning

So that they...

Interpret + construct simple pictograms and tally charts
Describe position, direction and movement including turns.
Understand and answer questions based on data (e.g. "Which has the most?" "How many altogether?")
Describe **position, direction, and movement**, including **quarter, half, and three-quarter turns**

Physical EducationChildren will:

- Have weekly indoor PE lessons
