We will be learning:

- To subitise within 3.
- To create their own patterns for numbers within 4.
- To use fingers to represent quantities.
- To know the last number in the count is the total number of objects.
- To practise counting developing 1:1 correspondence.
- To use the language of comparison, including 'more than' and 'fewer than'.

Understanding the World

We are learning:

- To talk about members of our immediate family and community.
- To name and describe people who are familiar to us.
- To draw information from a simple map.
- To recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.
- To recognise some environments that are different to the one in which we live.

Communication and Language, Literacy

We will be learning:

- To recite familiar and new nursery rhymes so they can broaden their language and develop confidence when speaking.
- To retell familiar stories such as 'Dan the flying man'.
- To read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.
- To form lower-case letters correctly.
- To blend sounds together and break sounds apart in spoken words.

Physical Development

We will be learning:

- To recap on movements already known such as jumping - running - hopping - skipping - climbing: Use of outdoor area.
- To use a good posture when sitting at a table or sitting on the floor: Yoga.
- To further develop the skills needed to manage the school day successfully: - lining up and queuing - mealtimes - personal hygiene.
- To develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools.
