Ofsted defines cultural capital as:

“the essential knowledge pupils need to be educated citizens, introducing them to the best that has been thought and said and helping to engender an appreciation of human creativity and achievement..”

 - *Cultural capital won't be judged as a separate thing but should be “a golden thread, woven through everything you do to teach children well”.*

 - Incorporate British Values (Democracy; The rule of law; Individual liberty; Mutual respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs)
