Children will:

- Explore and orally engage with 'The Bear and The Piano' and 'The Journey Home'
- Write daily for a range of purposes
- Use a range of punctuation in their written work
- Use adjectives, verbs and adverbs to write descriptive sentences
- Use conjunctions to extend their sentences
- Critically read their own work to edit and improve
- Research and decipher through information to support their knowledge
- Take part in Daily Supported Reading
- Have daily phonics or grammar lessons

Verbally articulate their ideas clearly and confidently
Write and edit a successful descriptive story
Write and edit and publish a persuasive letter
Apply their phonics knowledge when writing and reading
Develop fluency and reading comprehension

Computing

Children will:

- Learn about E-Safety
- Identify different forms of IT
- Use a mouse to click and drag
- Use a keyboard to type, delete and edit
- So that they...
- Understand how to stay safe online
- Create rules for using technology responsibly



Art

Children will:

- Explore a range of Pop Art artists
- Trace famous works of art
- Explore colour effects and paint washes
- Work as a team

So that they...

Know famous pop art artists
Can use artist tools to create a collaborative artwork



Dreams and Goals

PSHE

Children will:

- Think about goals and successes
- Develop strategies to be successful
- Celebrate personal achievements and those of others

So that they...

Can say what they have achieved and how that made them feel
Identify areas of personal strength and development



Geography

Children will:

- Describe the human features of their local area, such as the buildings, types of homes and modes of transport
- Describe the physical features of their local area, such as the Thames
- Identify similarities and differences between London and another European city

So that they...

Can describe features of their local area
Can use geographical vocabulary accurately
Are able to make comparisons

Science

Children will:

- Learn about basic survival needs
- Explore the role of different food in our diets
- Consider why hygiene is an important factor of life
- Investigate the effects of exercise on our bodies
- Consider how offspring grow into adults

So that they...

Understand how human and animal young grow into adults
Can describe the basic needs of water, food and air
Can discuss the importance of exercise and healthy diet



Maths

Children will:

- Name and identify UK coins and notes
- Count in pounds and pence
- Compare amounts of money and find change
- Solve one and two step problems
- Explore multiplication as equal groups and as an array
- Explore division as grouping and sharing
- Begin to learn 2, 5, and 10 times tables

So that they...

Recognise and use symbols £ and p
Can use addition and subtraction when finding change
Recall and use multiplication and division facts
Develop a range of strategies to model multiplication and division



Religious Education

Children will:

- Explore a range of religious stories and texts
- Discuss the messages behind stories from different faiths

So that they...

Understand how we should care for others
Understand why it is important to care for the world

Physical Education

Children will:

- Have weekly outdoor ball skills lessons
- Have weekly team building lessons
- Practise controlling a ball with their feet

So that they...

Develop water confidence and can swim across the pool
Control a ball and participate in a range of games
Develop greater stamina, fitness and team skills
