So that they...

Write successful simple sentences

Write a complete sentence with a capital letter, finger spaces and punctuation including full stops.

Write and publish a 5 senses poem about fireworks

Plan, draft and edit a story with repetition

Write a recipe relating to the story Billy and the Beast

Apply their phonics knowledge when writing and reading

Develop fluency and reading comprehension

ComputingChildren will:

- Learn about online bullying
- Input simple commands on a beebot
- To predict outcomes of a set of instructions

So that they...

Develop their understanding of how to stay safe online

Run a set of commands on a device

ArtChildren will:

- Look close at living things
- Sketch patterns from observations
- Join different materials together
- Study the work of Noriko Ambe and Anna Whitehouse

So that they...

Can plan and create collages and/or sculptures representing living things

PSHEChildren will:

- Identify similarities and differences within my class
- Consider why bullying can happen

So that they...

Understand that it is ok to be different from other people

Know that it's ok to be friends with all people

Understanding their differences and celebrates them

GeographyChildren will:

- Look at photos of the local area
- Look at a range of maps
- Create maps of different locations
- Give directions using left, right, forwards, backwards

So that they...

Develop knowledge about their locality

Use locational and directional language

Devise a simple map involving a key

Start to recognise human and physical features of the local environment

ScienceChildren will:

- Discuss the 4 seasons
- Observe and measure the weather
- Identify changes between autumn and winter
- Explore how animals adapt in winter

So that they...

Can identify and observe changes across autumn and winter

Understand that the length of the day varies across the seasons

Describe the weather associated with the seasons

MathsChildren will:

- Work with numbers up to 10
- Explore addition and subtraction word problems
- Use First, then and now to model word problems
- Use a number line to count on and back
- Recognise and name 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Sort shapes according to a given criteria

So that they...

Become increasingly confident with numbers up to 10

Understand maths in the real world

Begin to develop a written strategy for addition and subtraction

Can talk about and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes including squares, rectangles, circles, cubes, pyramids and spheres

Religious EducationChildren will:

- Share what they celebrate
- Discuss shared family stories
- Learn about Christian and Jewish festivals

So that they...

Feel and recognise that they belong to special groups

Appreciate and compare different religions and cultures

Physical EducationChildren will:

- Have weekly indoor and outdoor PE lessons
- Explore movement, large and small shapes
- Practise rolling, passing, throwing and catching a ball

So that they...

Can move with confidence on apparatus

Create a sequence of movement

Control a ball with their hands and participate in ball games
