EYFS



- Jack and the Beanstalk (Nursery): Create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent objects.
- Nursey Rhymes (Nursery): Draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details; Use drawing to represent ideas like movement or loud noises;
- Three Little Pigs (Nursery): Develop their own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them. Join different materials and explore different textures
- Handa’s Surprise (Nursery): Explore colour and colourmixing; Show different emotions in their drawings
- Animals (Reception): They safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function.
- Ourselves (Reception): Children use what they have learnt about media and materials in original ways, thinking about uses and purposes. They represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings
