

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will learn to:

- I am starting to listen to others in my play and find a compromise in our ideas
- I can express my own needs and wants appropriately
- I am displaying increasing confidence in new situations
- I can talk about some healthy choices such as hand washing, food and exercise
- I ask for help from peers and adults when needed and show willingness and pride to help others
- I can initiate play and offer cues for peers to join in
- I can beginning to understand how others may be feeling
- I can listen to the ideas of others

Communication and Language

Children will learn to:

- I can retell simple familiar stories
- I can listen and attend to longer stories with the help of pictures
- I can listen to ideas from peers and adults and incorporate them in my play
- I can use new vocabulary to describe things I can see
- I am building a repertoire of poems and songs
- I can continue a conversation
- I can use the correct tense when speaking

Maths

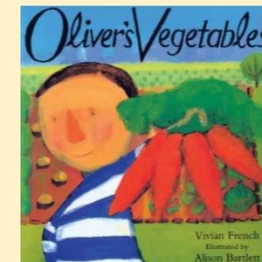
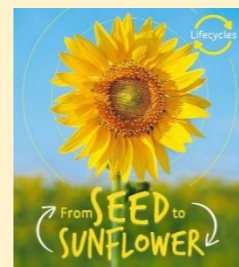
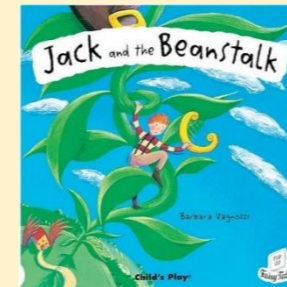
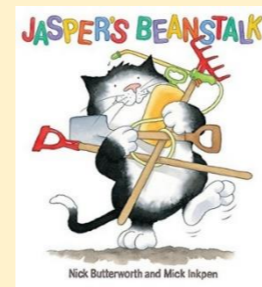
Children will learn to:

- I can recognise and recite numbers to 5 and beyond
- I count with 1:1 correspondence to 5
- I can subitise to 6
- I can compare 2 quantities noticing more or fewer
- I am beginning to understand the cardinal principal (that a number represents an amount)
- I can compare the height of 2 or more objects
- I can explore volume and capacity and use some language to describe this
- I can sequence familiar nursery rhymes / routines
- I can use positional language
- I can talk about the properties of 2d shapes and some 3d

Book Bags and Reading

Children need to be read to EVERY DAY. We change books on Tues and Thurs. You may change books more often using the blue box outside class.

- Turn the pages, talk about book features such as page numbers, blurb, author, recognise non-fiction
- Use the picture clues - predict what might happen
- Talk about the story - respond to simple questions
