- Have daily phonics or grammar lessons

Develop decoding fluency and reading comprehension

- Represent ideas of space in music
- Listen to and discuss music by Gustav Holst
- Create a group composition of "Going to space"

HistoryChildren will:

- Learn about different explorers from the past
- Look at pictures and videos from the past
- Discuss similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods

Understand where the people and events they study fit within a timeline

Use a wide vocabulary of historical terms

PSHEChildren will:

- Talk about the life cycles of animals and humans
- Make a timeline of their lives from birth to now
- Discuss the difference between boys and girls

Understand that everyone is unique and special

Can express how they feel when things change

Understand changes that have happened to them in life

Look forward to growing up

ArtChildren will:

- Explore the colours of Turner's seascapes
- Paint with watercolours
- Learn about different techniques with watercolours
- Use wax to create paint resistant effects

So that they...

Know the work of famous British painter JMW Turner

Understand how to use watercolour paint effectively

Create a seascape painting using multiple paint techniques

ScienceChildren will:

- Learn about famous scientist and inventors
- Revisit knowledge and skills learnt throughout this year
- Complete practical investigations

So that they...

Deepen their understanding of scientific concepts that have been taught this year

Develop working scientifically skills

MathsChildren will:

- Count forwards and backwards within 100
- Compare and order numbers
- Explore coins and notes
- Talk about ordering events using before and after
- Learn the names of days and months
- Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour

So that they...

Describe position, direction and movement including turns

Can say one more/less than a number

Recognise money

Recognise and use language relating to a dates, days, weeks, months and years.

Can tell the time and draw hands on a clock face

Religious EducationChildren will:

- Identify who cares for us
- Explore ways to help people
- Learn what it means to care for others

So that they...

Understand how to show kindness, help others, and treat people with respect and empathy.

Physical Education

- Have weekly indoor PE lessons and swimming lessons
- Use floats and supports while swimming
- Develop their understanding of attacking and defending
- Adopt different roles within a game

Develop water confidence and can swim across the pool
