## Times tables:

By the end of year 3, children are expected to know their 2-, 3-, 4-, 5-, 8- and 10-times tables. By the end of year 4 children are expected to know their 1-12 times tables

Children should also learn division facts related to the times table they are working on. For example, children should know that  $5 \times 3 = 15$ , so  $15 \div 5 = 3$ .
