Can describe the basic needs of water, food and air

Can discuss the importance of exercise and healthy diet

MathsChildren will:

- Name and identify UK coins and notes
- Count in pounds and pence
- Compare amounts of money and find change
- Solve one and two step problems
- Explore multiplication as equal groups and as an array
- Explore division as grouping and sharing
- Begin to learn 2, 5, and 10 times tables

So that they...

Recognise and use symbols £ and p

Can combine amount of money to make a particular amount

Can use addition and subtraction when finding change

Recall and use multiplication and division facts

Develop a range of strategies to model multiplication and division

Religious EducationChildren will:

- Learn about Muslim beliefs
- Retell a Muslim story
- Talk about issues of good and bad, right and wrong

So that they...

Understand who is a Muslim and what they believe

Ask some questions about believing in God

Physical EducationChildren will:

- Explore a range of movements and poses to create a flow of motions inspired by superheroes
- Dribble and pass a ball to a partner

So that they...

Develop a short organised and controlled dance

Play a range of ball games in different groupings involving a of passing and movement skills
