


<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The UK is split into regions and counties.</li> <li>Each county has its own distinct geographical features. Some are physical and some are human.</li> <li>Ordnance Survey Maps are created of smaller areas of the UK.</li> <li>Four figure grid references are used to find specific locations on Ordnance Survey Maps.</li> <li>Maps used symbols and a key to show important features of a place.</li> </ul>	<b>conservation</b> 	Protecting the environment and preventing wasteful use of our natural resources.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Every county in the world has access to natural resources. Not every country has access to the same resources, though.</li> <li>In the UK, we get our food, power and water from a range of sources. Some of these are renewable, and some are non-renewable.</li> <li>The way we use our natural resources now will decide whether there are enough natural resource for future generations in the UK to use.</li> </ul>
	<b>energy source</b> 	We need energy to power our homes, run our cars and charge our devices. This energy can be created in a range of ways.	
	<b>food miles</b> 	We use food miles to calculate how far our food travels to get from the place where it is made to us.	
	<b>minerals</b> 	Minerals are found naturally in the ground. They can have important uses.	
	<b>natural resources</b> 	Resources which are found naturally. Not every country has access to the same natural resources.	
	<b>non-renewable</b> 	Some resources are non-renewable, like coal and oil. This means we only have a limited amount.
